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Demonstrate Due Diligence

Any organization, post crisis, generally should be able to demonstrate due diligence preparedness.

If you can't demonstrate due diligence preparation, liability may increase.

What can teams put in place today?

Change Processes

Example: Create a first layer of lockdown by having teachers close and lock classroom doors.

Deterrence

Examples: Invite local law enforcement to use your parking lot to write reports, have a school resource officer.

Visitor Management

Examples: Controlling access to your building and asking for ID. Making sure the people in charge of visitor management have the information they need to effectively screen people – eg. custodial info.

Having representation from different stakeholders within the organization on your safety and security team is beneficial.



5 Recommendations

1. Physical Security Assessment of Facility

look for opportunities specifically for improvement regarding an intruder threat and response.

2. Plans and Policies

Make sure you have plans and policies in place, not only for disasters and weather, but for all types of crisis, including violent events, illness, non-custodial parent searching for child, etc.

3. Know the Policies and Procedures

Educate your faculty and staff so they know what to do and where to locate them.

4. Training

Overcome barriers to training and check out options in your community and/or options like Strategos. – Remember when working with local law enforcement on training or assessments – make sure they are telling you (the true first responder) what you need to do prior to law enforcement getting there.

5. **Drill Occasionally**

Communication is key, so visitors to the school know a drill is happening.
