FERPA Requirements

The Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA), 20 U.S.C. 1232g, gives certain rights to students concerning the privacy of, and access to, their educational records. FERPA requires covered colleges and universities to obtain written consent from an eligible student before it can disclose protected information from a student's education records to a third party, including a student's parents, absent an exception authorized by law. An eligible student is a student who reaches the age of 18 or attends a postsecondary institution at any age.
